



Educator's Guide to Photoshop Inserting Yourself in other Images

Overview:

This lesson is a guide for helping students place a person in a different setting.

Lesson Directions

Prep Time:

15 -60 minutes

Prior to Lesson:

Teacher Prep:

- Setup PowerCourse or Google Drive turn in
- Put images that we will work with in shared work-space (google Drive or student server)
- Have students take pictures of themselves to insert

Student Prep:

- (optional) Take pictures of themselves

Time Needed for Lesson:

- 60 minutes

Directions:

1. Take a full portrait of a student standing with a blank background. Have student upload to their computer and put in a folder.
2. Have student use a photo that we have provided to begin practice with
3. Open photoshop and take a tour of the workspace.
4. Open Bridge and take a tour of the workspace.
5. Open image1 and practice using the lasso tool to cut out image.
6. Open image 2 and cut out the person. Use content fill aware to fill in the space.
7. Use clone tool to finish cleaning where the person was at.
8. Create a new layer in image 2. Paste the image from image1 on the new layer.
9. Hide image 2 and finish erasing and cleaning up image 1 that was cut out.
10. Resize and move image 1 to appropriate location.
11. Continue to clean image 1 so that it fits nicely into image 2.
12. Use the dodge and burn tool to adjust the lighting so that they match.
13. Use the blur tool to finish adjusting image lighting.
14. Performance Task: Ask students to locate an image of someplace they will go and insert themselves into this image.
15. Have a presentation slideshow of the images to share in “The places we can go”

Extension / Challenge:

Idea 1: Have students imagine where they would like to be in 5 years from now and place themselves in that picture.

Idea 2: Have students imagine a person that they respect the most and have them add themselves next to that person with a quote at the bottom from that person.

Idea 3: Have students place themselves in an ad campaign for a product to promote it.
